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## **Chapter I. Organisation.**

### **Article 1. Definition of the event.**

Competitors and drivers should not be under suspension of competition licence or driving license.

The Clerk of the Course must inflict the penalties set out in the sporting regulations. For all cases not provided in the regulations, the will hand over a report to the Panel of the Stewards of the Meeting, that will apply the regulations provided by the International Sporting Code (article 12) or National Sporting Code.

Right of Appeal :

- the amount of the National Right of Appeal is € 2.000,00

- the amount of the International Right of Appeal (FIA) is € 6.000,00
